Expendi-4 tures shall include all expenditures of the United States 5 except those for payment of debt, and receipts shall in-6 clude all receipts of the United States except those derived from borrowing. Congress shall achieve balance within 10 8 years following the date of the ratification of this article. 9 "Section 2. For emergency situations, Congress may, for limited times, authorize expenditures exceeding 10 11 those allowable under section 1, if two-thirds of the House 12 of Representatives and the Senate agree to pass the bill.
