A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Homeland Security to develop performance metrics relating to the detection, deterrence, and seizure of illicit fentanyl, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Measuring Illicit
5 Fentanyl Trafficking Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. COMBATTING ILLICIT FENTANYL.**

7 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment
8 of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security shall—

1 (1) ensure that each component of the Depart-
2 ment of Homeland Security engaged in the detec-
3 tion, deterrence, and seizure of illicit fentanyl—

4 (A) to the extent practicable, collaborates
5 and shares relevant information and data relat-
6 ing to the detection, deterrence, and seizure of
7 illicit fentanyl with other components of the De-
8 partment engaged in such detection, deterrence,
9 and seizure or the measurement thereof; and

10 (B) identifies any barriers to sharing rel-
11 evant information and data pursuant to para-
12 graph (1); and

13 (2) establish performance metrics relating to
14 the detection, deterrence, and seizure of illicit
15 fentanyl for the Department and for each component
16 of the Department and ensure that such metrics
17 align with any strategic objectives and goals of the
18 Department relating to the efforts of the Depart-
19 ment to combat illicit fentanyl trafficking.
